Data was analyzed as per objective wise taking the help of tables and graph

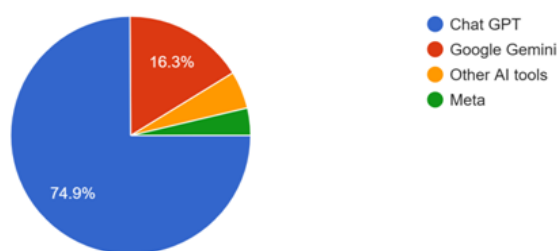
LIMITATION OF THE STUDY

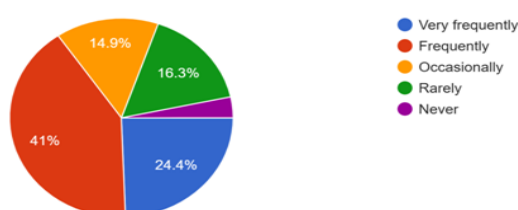
Objective 1: To analyze the role of AI technologies in transforming traditional education system into digital learning environment.

The above graph shows how there is transformation in education, from chalk and board to AI technology based learning. The below graph shows that students are spending more time AI

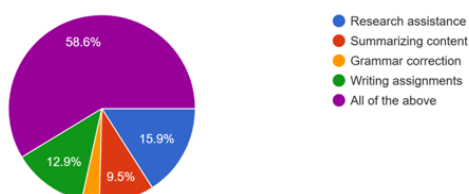

Objective 2: To examine how AI based tools enhances teaching learning outcomes.

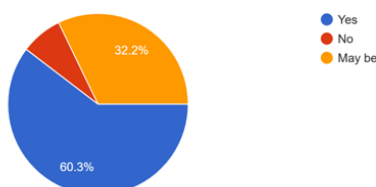
